1 Peter 2:18-25

[18] Servants, be subject to your masters with all respect, not only to the good and gentle but also to the unjust.

**[19] For this is a gracious thing, when, mindful of God, one endures sorrows while suffering unjustly.**

[20] For what credit is it if, when you sin and are beaten for it, you endure? But if when you do good and suffer for it you endure, this is a gracious thing in the sight of God.

**[21] For to this you have been called, because Christ also suffered for you, leaving you an example, so that you might follow in his steps.**

[22] He committed no sin, neither was deceit found in his mouth.
