

GENERAL GUIDELINES AT WBCC

Masks: For our 8:30am outdoor service we recommend wearing a mask at all times. For our 10:45 am service, we strongly recommend wearing a mask at all times while in our building, unless a medical condition prevents an individual from doing so.

Wrist bands: All attendees are asked to practice social distancing while in the building. We are providing colored wrist bands to help you appropriately practice social distancing.

Occupancy: We will seek to adhere to occupancy limits for each room to help comply with social distancing guidelines. Some environments may have adaptations to the guidelines, but ministry leaders will communicate those on a case-by-case basis.

Restrooms: As a courtesy to others, wear your mask to and from the restroom.

Refreshments: No meals, potlucks, or self-serve drink options will be available during this time.

Pre-existing conditions: We strongly recommend that those with pre-existing health conditions and/or those who are considered high-risk continue to engage with the Sunday worship service online.

Reporting: The church will not disclose anyone's medical information as it is illegal to require people to disclose things. People have rights under ADA/HIPPA in regards to their medical information that we will never violate. We do ask that if a person contracts COVID and have attended a service indoors or outdoors with Wells Branch Community Church that they let the leadership know. Further we ask that those that have contracted COVID and have attended WBCC within two-three weeks of their diagnosis to share their status via a COVID slack page where all reporting will go so that all can stay aware of any new COVID updates. If you are not on slack, please email info@wellsbranchchurch.com and we will get you set up. If you have contracted COVID please wait until you have tested negative and have been given the all clear to rejoin our gatherings.

STEPS WE ARE TAKING AS WBCC

Doors: The greeting team and ushers will open all doors for you. Please enter through the porch ramp on the east side of the building when attending a service.

Masks: Staff and volunteers will be wearing masks at all times.

Hand sanitizer: You will find stations at the porch entrance and exits. Please use the hand sanitizer as you enter and exit. All children's classrooms have hand sanitizer dispensers installed by the door as well.

Giving: A giving box will be provided at each entrance and exit to the Worship Center.

Worship Center:

We have removed rows so that every row is physically distanced from another. Each family unit needs to be at least 2 seats distanced from another family unit. The ushers will assist you if there are any questions on safe distancing.

Chairs, doors, and restrooms will be disinfected between services.

When on stage, the worship band and speakers may remove their masks, but will wear masks when off the stage.

Families: All families with kids of all ages are welcome to attend, and we ask that family units sit together once in the Worship Center. Families checking in their child(ren) to the Branch Kid's Ministry will enter through the Live For More Center (LFMC) entrance.

SPECIFIC GUIDELINES FOR CHILDREN AND STUDENTS

Masks: Masks are available at the LFMC entrance.

Staff and volunteers are required to wear masks.

Masks are optional for children.

We ask that parents wear masks in hallways for drop-off and pick-up of their child(ren).

Temperature checks: We will be checking the temperature of anyone who enters the LFMC.

Parents: We are asking parents to...

Register your children each week for service, due to social distancing and capacity limitations.

Wear masks in hallways for drop-off and pick-up of their child(ren). Masks are available at the LFMC entrance.

Line up on the west side of the building for the check-in process.

Have only one parent drop off and pick up, if possible, to reduce the number of people gathering in mass.

Exit the LFMC through the SHOOTS room only.
