All Things Are Possible with God! (Part 2)

Mark 10:32-52

Matthew 20:17-34; Luke 18:31-43 (Parallel Scriptures)

Read Mark 10:32-34 (Matthew 20:17-19) (Luke 18:31-34)

1. How does Jesus prepare His disciples for what is going to happen? Luke 18:34 describes the disciples: **34 And they understood none of these things: and this saying was hid from them, neither knew they the things which were spoken.**

Read Mark 10:35-45 (Matthew 20:20-28)

2. Why did the other disciples get upset with James and John?
3. What did Jesus mean in Mark 10:39?
4. Why was Jesus' explanation shared with all of the disciples? After hearing Jesus prophesy, what would you have asked Him?

Read Mark 10:46-52 (Matthew 20:29-34) (Luke 18:35-43)

5. Why did the disciples rebuke the blind man (men)? Matthew 20:30's narrative records 2 blind men, but Mark and Luke only record 1 blind man.
6. Jesus is omniscient, so why was it necessary for Him to ask the question, "What do you want me to do for you?"
7. How do we know that the blind man (men) believed that Jesus could restore their sight?
8. All things are possible with God...how has this statement touched you during our break apart from each other during the month of July or during another time?
