Read Mark 11:1-11; Matthew 21:1-9, Luke 19:29-38; John 12:12-15

1. What is significant about Luke 2:6-7 and Mark 11:2-3?
2. Why did the colt have to be one that was unriden? (Numbers 19:2, Deuteronomy 21:3, Samuel 6:7)
3. Is it amazing to you that everyone seemed to praise Jesus when He entered Jerusalem riding on a colt? How did they know?

Read Mark 11:12-26 (Matthew 21:18-22)

4. How do you interpret vs. 12-14 about Jesus and the fig tree?
5. Read Malachi 3:2-3. How do these verses relate to Matthew 11:15-18?
6. What necessities/mindsets are essentials for our prayers? What does it look like to pray in faith without doubts?
7. Does vs. 24 mean that all of our prayers will be answered as long as we have faith? What mountains are you trying to go around or climb?

Read Mark 11:27-33 (Matthew 21:23-27, Luke 20:1-8)

8. What temple courts are referred to? How did Jesus use His authority? Were the questions asked because the chief priests, teachers of the law, and elders wanted to follow Jesus, too? In not answering their question, was the answer given?
