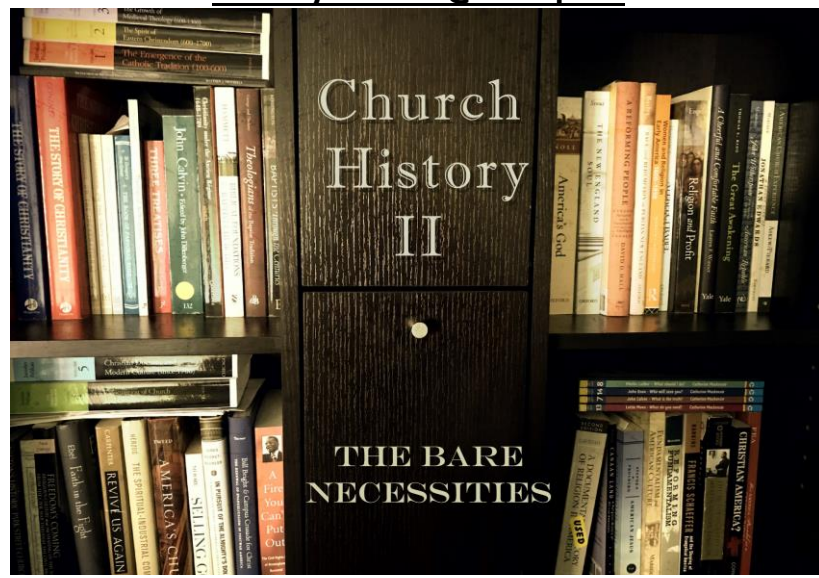

He Heals the Brokenhearted

[1] Praise the LORD! For it is good to sing praises to our God; for it is pleasant, and a song of praise is fitting.

[2] The LORD builds up Jerusalem; he gathers the outcasts of Israel.

[3] He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds.

[4] He determines the number of the stars; he gives to all of them their names.

[5] Great is our Lord, and abundant in power; his understanding is beyond measure.

[6] The LORD lifts up the humble; he casts the wicked to the ground.
