- Discuss how it would look for you to be judged by the same standard you use to judge others.
- **Read Matthew 7:3-5**
- What do you think Jesus is trying to teach his disciples in this passage?
- How does this passage help us to understand how we are to view people who are not followers of Jesus?
- **Read Matthew 7:6**
- Take some time and discuss what Jesus is telling his disciples in this passage and how it relates to how we interact with someone who does not follow Jesus.
