

Internship Program

DESCRIPTION

White Flag Church has created an Internship Program that engages students in meaningful work, allows them to pursue personal growth and gain ministry and/or nonprofit experience. Our program includes internships in various areas such as Kids and Student Ministry, Guest Experience/Customer Service, Communications and Special Projects & Events (see attached descriptions).

PROGRAM DATES

The duration of the program will typically be as follows:

- Summer Internship: May-August
- Fall Internship: September- December
- Spring Internship: January-May

Internship program hours can be flexible to work with students' work and school schedules. The hours per week requirement is dependent on the individual internship but can be negotiable and flexible.

COMPENSATION

All of the internship opportunities within our program are unpaid, but we are willing to work with college advisors and encourage students to pursue college credit during the internship.

INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

This internship program is designed to develop young leaders who are interested in pursuing ministry or working with a non-profit organization as an occupation.

ROLE DESCRIPTION

An intern with Student Ministry will be given the opportunity to learn how to teach God's word, work in youth ministry, coordinate volunteers, organize and execute events and support the Student Ministry and Family Ministry staff.

- Help plan and execute summer camps.
- Learn how to provide sound teaching of God's word. (Opportunity to teach up to three times over the internship).
- Learn how to create fun and exciting environments to connect students to community throughout the summer.
- Attend Intern Program meetings
- Attend White Flag Church staff meetings and Family Ministry Team meetings.
- Execute various tasks and responsibilities which support the Student Ministry Team and other White Flag staff.
