

ARE YOU A GREAT COMMISSION CHRISTIAN?

Acts 8:26-40

I. A Great Commission Christian is obedient to the voice of God (26-27a).

Acts 1:8: But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and **you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.**

II. A Great Commission Christian is led by the Spirit of God (27b-31).

John 14:17: the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; **but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you.**

Ephesians 5:18: And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; **but be filled with the Spirit.**

III. A Great Commission Christian is dependent upon the Word of God (32-35).

Romans 10:14: How then shall they call on Him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher?

Romans 10:17: Faith comes by hearing, and **hearing by the word of God.**

IV. A Great Commission Christian is focused on the Son of God (36-39).

Isaiah 53:7-8: He was oppressed and He was afflicted, yet He opened not His mouth; He was led as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before its shearers is silent, so He opened not His mouth. He was taken from prison and from judgment, and who will declare His generation? For He was cut off from the land of the living; for the transgressions of My people He was stricken.

1 Corinthians 2:1-2: And I, brethren, when I came to you, did not come with excellence of speech or of wisdom declaring to you the testimony of God. **For I determined not to know anything among you except Jesus Christ and Him crucified.**

V. A Great Commission Christian is consumed with the mission of God (40).

Luke 19:10: For the Son of Man **came to seek and to save that which was lost.**
