

JESUS' RESURRECTED BODY AND MINE, TOO
1 Corinthians 15:42-49

I. The Contrasts of the Resurrection (42-44).

Psalm 103:14-16: **For He knows our frame; He remembers that we are dust.** As for man, his days are like grass; as a flower of the field, so he flourishes. For the wind passes over it, and it is gone, and its place remembers it no more.

1 Peter 1:3-4: Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again to **a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, to an inheritance incorruptible** and undefiled and that does not fade away, reserved in heaven for you.

II. The Prototype of the Resurrection (45-49).

Genesis 2:7: And the Lord God formed man *of* the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living being.

Romans 5:14: Nevertheless death reigned from Adam to Moses, even over those who had not sinned according to the likeness of the transgression of Adam, **who is a type of Him who was to come.**

1 John 3:2: Beloved, now we are children of God; and it has not yet been revealed what we shall be, **but we know that when He is revealed, we shall be like Him,** for we shall see Him as He is.
