

**PRAYING TO EQUIP GOD'S WILL**  
**Hebrews 13:20-21**

**I. God's will in our lives begins with salvation in Jesus Christ (20).**

**A. Jesus' resurrection gave us peace with the Father.**

Romans 5:1: Therefore, having been justified by faith, **we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.**

1 Thessalonians 5:23: Now may **the God of peace** Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

**B. Jesus' resurrection gave us a shepherd for our soul.**

John 10:11, 14: **I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd** gives His life for the sheep. **14 I am the good shepherd;** and I know My sheep, and am known by My own.

**C. Jesus' resurrection gave us an eternal covenant.**

Matthew 26:28: For this is **My blood of the new covenant**, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.

Hebrews 9:15: And for this reason He is the **Mediator of the new covenant, by means of death**, for the redemption of the transgressions under the first covenant, that those who are called may receive the promise of the eternal inheritance.

**II. God's will in our lives continues with glorifying Jesus Christ (21).**

**A. God equips us to glorify Jesus.**

Ephesians 2:10: For we are His workmanship, **created in Christ Jesus for good works**, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.

Ephesians 4:7: But **to each one of us grace was given** according to the measure of Christ's gift.

**B. God is glorified through Jesus alone.**

Hebrews 1:3: **who being the brightness of His glory** and the express image of His person, and upholding all things by the word of His power, when He had by Himself purged our sins, sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high.

John 17:24: Father, I desire that they also whom You gave Me may be with Me where I am, **that they may behold My glory which You have given Me;** for You loved Me before the foundation of the world.
