

MONEY IS A WORTHLESS IDOL
Psalm 135:15-18

I. Money is a worthless idol because it is created (15).

Genesis 1:1: **In the beginning God** created the heavens and the earth.

Psalm 90:2: Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever You had formed the earth and the world, even **from everlasting to everlasting, You are God.**

II. Money is a worthless idol because it is dead (16-17).

1 Kings 18:26, 29: So they took the bull which was given them, and they prepared it, and called on the name of Baal from morning even till noon, saying, "O Baal, hear us!" **But there was no voice; no one answered.** Then they leaped about the altar which they had made. And when midday was past, they prophesied until the *time* of the offering of the *evening* sacrifice. **But there was no voice; no one answered, no one paid attention.**

Psalm 29:4: The **voice of the Lord** is powerful; **the voice of the Lord** is full of majesty.

Proverbs 15:3: **The eyes of the Lord are in every place**, keeping watch on the evil and the good.

Psalm 10:17: Lord, You have heard the desire of the humble; You will prepare their heart; **You will cause Your ear to hear.**

Psalm 18:15 Then the channels of the sea were seen, the foundations of the world were uncovered at Your rebuke, O Lord, **at the blast of the breath of Your nostrils.**

III. Money is a worthless idol because it is powerless (18).

Ezekiel 36:25: Then I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you shall be clean; **I will cleanse you from all your filthiness and from all your idols.**

John 10:10: The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. **I have come that they may have life**, and that they may have it more abundantly.
