THE UNITY OF THE CHURCH Ephesians 4:1-6

I. A unifying church member will respond to the call of unity (1).
Ephesians 1:18: the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints.

1 Peter 2:9: But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him **who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light.**

II. A unifying church member will develop the character of unity (2-3).

Philippians 2:3: Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself.

Philippians 4:5: Let your gentleness be known to all men. The Lord is at hand.

Colossians 3:12, 14: Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, put on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, **longsuffering.** 14 But above all these things put on love, **which is the bond of perfection.**

- III. A unifying church member will submit to the God of unity (4-6).
 - A. Unity in God the Spirit (4).

Ephesians 2:22: in whom you also are being built together for a dwelling place of God in the Spirit.

B. Unity in God the Son (5).

Romans 12:5: so we, *being* many, **are one body in Christ**, and individually members of one another.

C. Unity in God the Father (6).

1 Corinthians 8:6: yet for us there is one God, the Father, of whom are all things, and we for Him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, through whom are all things, and through whom we live.
