*For the week following February 16, 2020*

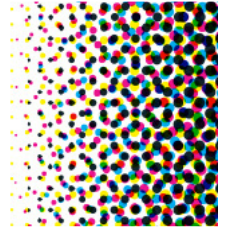
1. How do you decide whether to serve or not serve in a given area (not just church, but life)?
