

Neighborhood Scavenger Hunt

Instructions for Parents: Read through the instructions below with your child. Older kids can do this pretty independently, but you will have to greatly assist your smaller kids. This is a good thing. Find the items together and pray for each thing mentioned together. Identify a prize (ice cream, candy bar, etc...) that you can give your child for completing the scavenger hunt. As you walk, remember your kids' legs and attention spans are short. Avoid the temptation of getting frustrated easily, but look for opportunities to make this a great experience for the whole family.

Instructions for Kids: You are about to go on a really cool prayer walk! As you walk, look for each of the things below. When you find it, pray the prayer that is listed in the box. Mark out the box when you are done with it. See if you can have all the boxes marked out before your prayer walk is over!

Find a house with a fence.

Pray for God to protect the family that lives there.

Find a house with children's toys in the yard.

Pray that those kids would trust in Jesus early.

Find a mailbox with a "7" on it.

Pray that God would help that family turn to Him for what they need.

Find a house with a dog.

Pray that God would help the family inside be loyal to Him.

Find a house with flowers.

Pray for God to help the family show love to each other.

Find a person who is outside.

Tell them that God loves them and ask them how you can pray for them.
(Make sure your grownup is with you!)

Find a house with a flag.

Pray that God would help the family feel His peace today.

Find a house with a "for sale" sign.

Ask God to help the house sell.

Find a house with a green door.

Ask God to help that family trust in Jesus.

Find a house with a car in the driveway.

Ask God to help the family depend on Him wherever they go.

Find a stop sign.

Ask God to help all of the people in the neighborhood stop to think about Him.

Find a house with front steps.

Ask God to help the family take a new step towards knowing Him more.
