Missions Update

Pastor Chuck and Wyema Phillips, MTW church plant, Europe.

In 2005 Pastor Chuck and Wyema arrived in Europe to reach out to Muslim immigrants. During this time they have been blessed to witness God doing some amazing things in the lives of Persians. Now, after much prayer the Lord is leading them to return to the US in late September.

Health is the major reason. In two years Chuck had two open heart surgeries, several bouts of serious infection, and has found it hard not to regain his pre-surgery strength and endurance. Looking forward to ministry in the lives of their children and grandchildren in the Atlanta area, for 9-12 months after returning, they plan to continue as employees of their mission, visit supporters and supporting churches to give a final report through summer 2021.
