Inquirer's Class: Are you considering joining Westminster? New to Reformed theology or Presbyterianism? Looking to get to know the leadership of our church? Come join us for an Inquirer's Class on Sunday mornings, during the Sunday school hour (9-10am) August 7 - September 11. This class will be co-taught by all of our elders and will cover the basics of our church's theology and philosophy of ministry.

Class is also open those considering membership, current members who may have missed portions of earlier Inquirer's classes or who simply want to brush up on these basics, or long-time members who want to heckle the elders during class (just kidding).

Communicants Class: Starting in September, our church will be offering a Communicants Class. Children will complete a workbook which covers the basics of the Christian faith, as well as the basics of church membership.

Child Protection Policy Annual Renewal Meeting

Attention <u>all</u> Volunteers with youth, children's, and nursery ministries at Westminster, Our church's Child Protection Policy calls for an annual renewal process to be implemented every August. Part of that process is mandatory instruction and ongoing education in the church's policies and procedures related to all children's and youth ministries.

On <u>Sunday August 28 at 4pm</u>, our Child Protection Policy Administrator, Pastor Knox, along with our Assistant Director of Student and Family Ministries, Melissa Giddens, and our Nursery Coordinator, Krystina Lyon, will offer this ongoing education and instruction over Zoom. This meeting is <u>mandatory</u> for all current regular volunteers and for all those interested in becoming regular volunteers with any of our programs that involve children or youth. If you are not able to be present for this meeting, <u>there will be a recording available</u> for you to access.

All volunteers <u>must</u> either attend this meeting <u>or</u> watch the recording before September 1, 2022, in order to maintain their statuses as regular volunteers with any of our children's, youth, or nursery ministries.
