Faith. Instruction in Luther's Small Catechism and Private Absolution are required for all new members. Please ask the Pastor for further details.



Here the Holy Spirit invites and gathers His holy Church. He does so that you might dine with your Lord by feeding on the Supper of His Body and Blood. We are pleased that you also are numbered with the Faithful today and pray that the same Holy Spirit may enlighten and sanctify you through this Holy Mass.

The Theme of Today's Liturgy God alone is truly wise. The ways of the world are foolishness. So the things of the world are used foolishly. Land, oxen, marriage, all good gifts of God, become to sinful men the very things

that separate sinners from the only cure for their sin. But God bids us to forsake foolishness and live. He invites every man to go in the way of understanding, the way of love. This is the sign we have passed from death to life. So the fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, and knowledge of the Holy One is understanding. That wisdom, that understanding, receives with thanksgiving the gracious invitation of God to His Great Supper, that His House be filled.

The Sermon The Wisdom of God is Christ. Wisdom has built His House, the Holy Church. He has hewn out the Seven Pillars, the Sevenfold Gifts of the Spirit, on which the Church stands. He has given Himself to be slaughtered, the Once For All Sacrifice. He has drunk of the Cup of God's wrath, mixing His Wine.

He has furnished His Table, at which He is Master and Host and Meal. Indeed, "All things are ready". And He invites you, you who believe in Him, you, O Redeemed of Christ, He bids you "Come, eat of My Bread and drink of the Wine I have mixed. Forsake foolishness and live, and go in the way of understanding."

The Holy Eucharist Our Lord Jesus Christ now prepares the Supper of our salvation. It is His Body and His Blood. And at His invitation, as weary souls with sins oppressed, we come to Him for needed rest, for comfort and for pardon. Come for all things are now ready.

THE PSALM FOR THIS WEEK IS PSALM 18. PRAY IT EVERY DAY!

This Psalm may be prayed in three parts: v 1-15; 16-30; 31-50. The focus is on the merciful rescue and gracious help Our Lord gives at all times. In the first part, we confess that Our Lord delivers us in times of distress (v 6). In the second part, we remember that the Lord's deliverance and support is what makes us righteous, clean, blameless, merciful, humble and pure in His sight. In the third part, we recount how the Lord delivers—by being our strong Rock, by giving us victory over our enemies, and by lifting us up above those who go against us. And what is our response? To bless God and give thanks for His victory over death—a victory which He gives over entirely to us. (v 46-50)
