The Scarlet Thread is God's promise of redemption and its fulfillment through a Savior, His Son, Jesus Christ. God wove men and women into the tapestry to bring about that promise. Over the weekend of our retreat, we will explore the lives of six of those women who, in some ways are very much like ourselves, as well as hear personal stories of redemption in the lives of women from our ZF body.

Come prepared to think, laugh, pray, sing, meet new people, and enjoy good conversation. Girls ages 13 and up, as well as moms with babies approximately six months and younger, are encouraged to attend the retreat!

Teaching Sessions

Friday Evening | Eve: Mother of All Living

We will start at the beginning of the Scarlet Thread with the very first woman, Eve. We will also hear from Karen and her story of God's redeeming love in her life.

Saturday Morning | Tamar: Shocking Righteousness

The story of Tamar has often been overlooked and confused. As we look in the pages of Scripture, we will see that she is a woman caught in terrible circumstances. Yet, surprisingly, God uses her to interrupt and transform the life of another. The result is blessing and redemption as the Scarlet Thread continues.

Saturday Morning | Rahab: From Fear to Faith

Rahab is an unlikely addition to the Scarlet Thread in many ways—she is a foreigner, she is an enemy, and she is a prostitute! God weaves the story of Rahab into His redemption tapestry as an example of a woman who chose faith over fear, and that faith caused her to act with bold courage.

Saturday Evening | Bathsheba: From Ashes to Beauty

Bathsheba is the daughter of one of the most prominent families in Judah, the wife of one of the king's most trusted soldiers, and the center of the darkest stain on David's legacy. Her story is one not only of God's redemption of sin and the sinner, but also that of the one sinned against.

Sunday Morning | Mary: Mother of Her Savior

We all have plans and dreams for our lives, but how do we react when life does not turn out like we expect? From a teenage girl surprised by an angel, to a grieving mother kneeling before her Son, Mary's life is surprisingly relatable as she grows in her understanding and trust in her Savior.
